Dear Campbell-Tintah Public School Families:

The Campbell-Tintah School District Administration was notified this morning of a lab-confirmed case of COVID-19 in a member of our school community on Monday, November 9, 2020. For privacy reasons, we cannot share details about the status of the person. At this time, they have been advised to stay home and away from other people (isolate). This is the first lab-confirmed case of COVID-19 from our school community this school year.

We have worked with Wilkin County Public Health officials and the Minnesota Department of Health to identify those who had close contact with the person and have communicated with them individually. The risk of exposure for other individuals present in the building on that date is no greater than the risk of contracting the virus in the general community. If you were not notified that you or your child had close contact with the person, you should still monitor for symptoms of illness, but do not need to stay home unless symptoms develop. If symptoms develop, stay home, and consult with your health care provider to determine if a medical evaluation is needed.

This is the first lab-confirmed case of COVID-19 from our school community this school year. The school district is asking all members of our school community to please help minimize the spread of COVID-19 by taking the following actions:

- Protect yourself and others by wearing a face covering
- Social distance yourself 6-feet away from people.
- Wash your hands often with soap and water.
- Cover your cough and sneeze and avoid touching your face with unwashed hands.
- If you are sick, stay home.

We will continue to work closely with Wilkin County Public Health and the Minnesota Department of Health to monitor this and any situation. Thank you for helping to keep our school community safe.
