Enrollment:

4-H Afterschool Program is open to all children K-4th grade.

Fees:

A fifteen dollars per child to help cover the cost of snacks and supplies. Scholarships are available: contact the Wilkin County Extension Office for more information. Checks should be made payable to Wilkin County 4-H. If a child chooses to no longer participate in the club after the program has begun, no refund of fees will be made.

Arrival and Pick up:

Transportation is not provided to or from the 4-H Afterschool Club and therefore is the responsibility of the family. Parents are asked to be prompt picking up his/her child. Leaders are unable to stay after the designated ending time.

Attendance:

4-H Afterschool Clubs do not function as a child care program. While roll call will be taken, staff will not follow up if your child is not in attendance. The greatest benefit from the Afterschool Club is consistent participation.

Behavior:

All members are expected to show respect for the leaders and other members. Any behavior concerns will be brought to the attention of the parent/guardian.



Curriculum:

The innovative "learn-by doing" 4-H curriculum will be used to introduce the club members to different project areas that they may explore.

Illness:

The Afterschool Club cannot provide care for sick children. Children who are ill should not attend program. A child should be picked up as soon as possible if he/she becomes ill.

Injuries:

In case of an emergency, parents/guardians will be contacted using the information provided on the enrollment/health form. Wilkin County 4-H has a medical policy to cover accidents during 4-H activities.

Medication:

The Afterschool Staff is not authorized to administer medications to members. If a student needs to take any medication, they will have to wait until returning home.

Parent Involvement:

Parents are always welcome and encouraged to visit and assist their child whenever possible. Please inform the leader of any special care and/or consideration that your child needs. Adults who would like to volunteer for the program are asked to contact the Extension Office for more information.



Other:

Periodically, additional information will be sent home with members. Members will receive information about other 4-H Adventures which they may chose to participate in. After-school members are encouraged to become involved with a 4-H Club, club contact information will be provided.
